Covid-19 Guidelines on the Farm:

2 HOUR FARM PASS & CORN MAZE - \$5

Pre-registration Required

Every Day 9am-6pm (last ticket sold at 4pm) (farm hours change seasonally).

All ages. 2 & under free. Purchase online & check-in at the Smokehouse! Limited tickets available per time slot. Grants access to the Valley Farm (Working Dairy Farm) & the Farmyard (Educational Venue) for a self-guided tour and to meet the farm animals.

STORYWALK - FREE

Open every day - 8am-dusk starts in the field outside of the Market. Take a self-guided 1 mile walk while stopping to read along the way.
