

# Pineland Farms Summer League

Pineland Farms Summer League will be a 18-week season played on both the Patriot and Minuteman course and will culminate in a championship finals event. Players will accumulate points based on their finish and weekly bonus points during each week of the regular season in the hopes of securing enough points to qualify for the finals and securing a share of the season payout.

This document outlines the principles governing the League. Membership is open to any and all individuals in agreement with the purposes of this league.

Those participating must sign the league form and agree to all rules on their first week of participation.

## LEAGUE WEEKLY FEES (MANDATORY)

\$5 Green fees (unless season pass holder, or using Pineland Farms coupon)

\$2 Finals

\$2 Ace pot

\$1 Weekly ctp

This money (\$10.00) needs to be paid in **CASH** to Pineland Farms before each league round.

If you choose to not pay for any portion of the full amount your round doesn't count.

## LEAGUE DETAILS

- This league will have a 18 week long regular season from Monday April 18th to Sunday August 21<sup>st</sup>.
- Finals will be held on the Patriot course starting August 29th
- Players will need to make 12 of the 18 weeks.
- Weekly points will be given as follows.

1 <sup>st</sup> place	4pts
2 <sup>nd</sup> place	3pts
3 <sup>rd</sup> place	2pts
Attendance	1pt
Ace	5pts
Point Ctp	1pt+

- The top 4 Point scorers in the regular season based on overall POINTS will receive **20%** of the final's money based on their standing.
- If there is a positional tie, players will all receive the point value of their finish. Example, Player 1 and Player 2 both shoot the low score of the week- they will both receive 4pts.
- Everyone attending will receive the attendance point, even the top 3 players of the week.
- Players can play their league round with a witness anytime Monday through Sunday.

- To qualify that week for the ACE & CTP after Monday night you MUST have a league witness with you. They don't need to be playing their league round, but they still need to be in contention for finals. Once they mathematically can't make finals, they no longer qualify as a league player.
- League rounds CAN be played during other Pineland Farms single tournaments and events.
- **Players need to sign in on the sheet and post their score after their round.**
- If Pineland Farms closes before the completion of your round send a message to Deven Pendexter so your score can be recorded.
- **PFSL is on UDisc – You can use UDisc for recording your round but still log your score into league folder.**

## LEAGUE FINALS & MONEY DISTRIBUTION

- ACE POT- Ace pot money will be handed out at the beginning of the next week. This allows for all players to have a chance to play for the pot, subsequently making it higher when rewarded.
- If no Ace is hit this season there will be an Ace throw off on Patriot hole 1 on the final Monday night of the summer league. **Only those players who still qualify as a league member (12 of 18 weeks) will be eligible.** Top 3 closest disc will split the Ace pot 3 ways 45% 32% 22%
- The top 4 finishers in the regular season based on overall POINTS will receive money based on their standing. **20%** of the final's money will be dispersed to the top 4 based on the PDGA payouts.  
1st- 41%, 2nd-26%, 3rd-19%, 4th-14%.
- Finals will be single elimination **match play** on the Patriot course.
- Higher seed is on top of the card
- A bracket for finals will be made up of only players that are attending finals. No player will receive a free pass to the next round based on someone not showing up.
- Brackets will be made after the final week of the regular season is complete.
- Money will be distributed to the top **8** Finishers of the playoffs.
- Final's money will be dispersed to the top 8 based on the PDGA payouts.

## LEAGUE RULES

- Everyone is on their honor to conduct themselves according to the rules and within the spirit of Competition.
- Players are expected to behave in a professional and sportsmanlike manner while participating in the Pineland Farms singles league. Actions that are in violation of this conduct include but are not limited to
  - Repeated and overt use of abusive or profane language.
  - Throwing items in anger (other than discs in play).
  - Overt rudeness or threatening behavior to anyone present.
  - Willful and overt destruction, abuse, or vandalism of property, including animal and plant life.
  - Excessive use of alcohol or public intoxication at the league site.

- If a Player violates the above standard, the League Officers may opt, in their sole discretion, to issue a warning for the first offence or ask the Player(s) to leave and complete their league round on another date.
- The following actions also violate the above standard. Players who commit one or more of these violations will not receive a warning, and will be immediately disqualified by the league officers:
  - Cheating: a willful attempt to circumvent the rules of play.
  - Physical attacks upon anyone present.
  - Public display or use of illegal or prohibited substances in violation of any applicable law (national/federal, state/provincial, local/city/county, et al).
- **\*\*Disqualified players shall forfeit any prize money or merchandise and shall not receive a refund of entry fees\*\***
- Any prizes that a player has earned will be distributed at the completion of the event once the results have been tabulated and verified. Because the league will be a week long, Week one prizes (Ace Pot / CTP) will be distributed at the beginning of week 2.
- Tournament Directors may award prizes earlier at their discretion.
- Players who leave before the official distribution of prizes do not relinquish their winnings but they are responsible for contacting the league directors as soon as possible to arrange for claiming those winnings and are also responsible for any associated shipping costs.
- Any prizes (cash or merchandise) that remain unclaimed (through no fault of the league directors) six months after the completion of the event are then relinquished by the player. League Directors must make a reasonable effort to provide the payout to the player by contacting them, offering to ship, etc.
