Players will accumulate points based on their fi	nish (attendance, ACE, and CTP's) each week of the regular season to

Tier status before heading out on the course! **AFTER week 7**, there will be no further movement of league players. **Each League player will remain in either Tier A, B, or C** based on their average score through week 7.

Each week, League directors will post the updated standings which will indicate which Tier each league player is in. The league players may move up or down between the Tiers each week based on their average scores. The tiers will be determined by their Average Score during the League, and divided evenly across the 3 Tiers. **PFSL will have different CTP's for each Tier** – allowing for a more widespread distribution of prizes.

Before playing the first week, players must check in at the Outdoor Center, and complete League paperwork.

Players must check in weekly and pay the League fees before playing their round each week. As an incentive for league members to play their rounds on Monday, PFSL will have a raffle for those players participating on Mondays. Raffle details on page 6.

If you're new to the sport or new to the area and are looking for others to play a round with; simply show up at Pineland Outdoor Center on Monday afternoons at 4:30 to get placed on a card.

This document outlines the principles governing the League. Membership is open to all individuals in agreement with the purposes of this league.

Those participating must sign the league rules and agree to all rules on their first week of participation.

LEAGUE WEEKLY FEES

MANDATORY:

\$8 Green fees (unless a season pass member, or using a Pineland Farms coupon) \$3 Finals – CASH – no IOU's

OPTIONAL:

\$2 Ace pot <u>CASH – no IOU's</u> \$2 Weekly CTP <u>CASH – no IOU's</u>

All fees must be paid to the Outdoor Center before the start of your round. The greens fees must be paid in full to Pineland Farms before each league round. League players will pay \$8 greens fees for their League round – even if they play on the weekend.

\$15 Fee (\$8 for greens fees - \$3 to finals jackpot - \$2 to ace pot - \$2 to weekly cash CTP)

LEAGUE DETAILS

- This league will have a 14-week-long regular season from Monday May 5th to Monday, August 4th.
- Finals will be held on courses to be determined beginning August 11th
- Players must record 10 attendance points from the 14 league weeks to be eligible for playoffs.
- Weekly points will be given as follows (each Tier).

1 st place	4pts
2 nd place	3pts
3 rd place	2pts
Attendance	1pt
Double Attendance week/s	2pt
Ace	5pts
Point CTP	1pt

- The top 4 Point scorers **per tier** in the regular season based on overall POINTS will receive 20% of the final's money based on their standing.
- If there is a positional tie, players will all receive the point value of their finish.
 - Example, Player 1 & Player 2 both throw the low score of the week they will both receive 4pts
- Everyone attending will receive the attendance point, including the top 3 players of the week.



- Players may play their league round with α witness anytime Monday through Sunday.
- To qualify that week for the ACE & CTP after Monday night you MUST have a league witness with you.
- The witness does not need to be playing their league round, but they still need to be in contention for finals.
- PFSL may ask for League witness proof/verification of any league rounds.
- Once a player is mathematically eliminated from finals, they no longer qualify as a league player.
- League rounds **CAN** be played during other Pineland Farms single tournaments and events.
- Players must sign in and post their score after their round.
- If Pineland Farms Outdoor Center closes before the completion of your round, please send a message to the Outdoor Center at Outdoor@PinelandFarms.org so your score can be recorded.
- PFSL is on UDisc You may use UDisc for recording your round.
- If using a paper scorecard, player names (first and last) must be written legibly

LEAGUE FINALS & MONEY DISTRIBUTION

- There will be separate Ace pots for each Tier.
- Ace pot will correspond to the Tier that the League player is playing for that week.
- Ace pot can be split multiple times and is awarded the following league week.
- If an ace is hit on Monday, then all added money for the rest of the week is theirs to win. If someone hits an ace any day of the same league week the full ace pot is split 50/50.
- ACE POT money will be handed out at the beginning of the next league week.
 This allows for all players to have a chance to play for the pot, subsequently making it higher when rewarded.
- If no Ace is hit this season, or the ace pot still has cash in it at the beginning of the playoffs there will be an Ace throw-off on a hole, to be determined, on the final Monday night of the summer league. Only those players who still qualify as a league member (attended 10 of 14 weeks) will be eligible. We will throw until an ace is recorded.
- Finals will be a single elimination **match play**. If there is a tie after 18 holes, play will continue starting with hole 1 until one player has the lowest score on a hole.
- Higher seed is on top of the card
- A bracket for finals for each tier will be made up of league players that have qualified for finals.
- Brackets will be made after the final week of the regular season is complete.
- After the season has concluded, the top 4 finishers in the regular season (per tier), based on overall POINTS will receive money based on their standing. 20% of the final's money will be dispersed to the top 4 based on the PDGA payouts. 1st- 41%, 2nd-26%, 3rd-19%, 4th-14%.

1 st place	41%

• The remaining 80% is split amongst the top 4 Players (per tier) based off bracket style playoff, using the same percentages as listed above (1st-41%,2nd-26%,3rd-19%,4th-14%).



LEAGUE RULES

- All players are on their honor to conduct themselves according to the rules and within the spirit of competition.
- Players are expected to behave in a professional and sportsmanlike manner while participating in the PFSL. Actions that violate this conduct include, but are not limited to:
- Repeated and overt use of abusive or profane language.
- Throwing items in anger (other than discs in play).
- Overt rudeness <u>or threatening behavior</u> to anyone present.
- Willful and overt destruction, abuse, or vandalism of property, including animal and plant life.
- Excessive use of alcohol or <u>public intoxication</u> at the league site.
- If a Player violates the above standard, the League Directors may opt, in their sole discretion, to issue a
- warning for the first offense or ask the Player(s) to leave and complete their league round on another date.
- The following actions also violate the above standard. Players who commit one or more of these violations
- will not receive a warning, and will be immediately disqualified by the league officers:
- Cheating: a willful attempt to circumvent the rules of play.
- Physical attacks upon anyone present.
- <u>Public display or use of illegal or prohibited substances in violation of any applicable law (national/federal, state/provincial, local/city/county, et al).</u>
- **Disqualified players shall forfeit any prize money or merchandise and shall not receive a refund of entry fees**
- Any prizes that a player has earned will be distributed at the completion of the event once the results have been tabulated and verified. Because the league is a week-long event, week one prizes (Ace Pot / CTP) will be distributed at the beginning of week 2.
- League Directors may award prizes earlier at their discretion.
- Players who leave before the official distribution of prizes do not relinquish their winnings, but they are responsible for contacting the league directors as soon as possible to arrange for claiming those winnings and are also responsible for any associated shipping costs.
- Any prizes (cash or merchandise) that remain unclaimed (through no fault of the league directors) six months after the completion of the event are then relinquished by the player. League Directors must make a reasonable effort to provide the payout to the player by contacting them, offering to ship, etc.
- As a player in the Pineland Farms Singles league I understand that my poor actions could have my league privileges terminated. I understand that all the money that I paid in will stay in the league if my actions lead to league termination.
- I understand that all the money that I paid in will stay in the league if I become statistically eliminated from the playoffs.
- I understand that I need to meet the 10-week requirement to qualify for the playoffs.
- I understand that the League is a weeklong event. Beginning Mondays and ending the following Sunday.
- Ace pots will be available, all week to league players. Ace pot winnings will be handed out at the following Monday League night.
- I understand I will need to wait a week to receive ACE pot money if hit. INTIAL



Finals qualifications

- Players must record 10 *attendance* points from the 14 league weeks to qualify for Playoffs (players can miss 4 weeks) or earn bonus attendance points by playing in the "Double Attendance Point Weeks".
- PFSL will collect each league player's phone number and email address to help facilitate the playoffs. PFSL will not share your personal information with other league members without your permission.

1 st place	4pts
2 nd place	3pts
3 rd place	2pts

EVERYONE, including the top 3 winners receives an attendance point for showing up that week!

- I understand the Point system
- I will submit a legible, clean score card.
- I understand my round may not be counted if the score card is not completed, smudged, or dirty.
- I understand I need a witness for my league round. To qualify each week for ACE & CTP I must have a **league** witness, (they do not need to be playing their league round, but they still need to be in contention for finals. Once a player mathematically can no longer make the finals, they no longer qualify as a league player) to be playing with you.
- I understand that I may be asked to provide proof of a league witness at any time during the league.
- I understand that the top 4 finishers in the regular season based on overall **POINTS** will receive money based on their standing.
- 20% of the final's money will be dispersed to the top 4 based on the PDGA payouts.
 - o 1st- 41%, 2nd-26%, 3rd-19%, 4th-14%.
- I understand that if no ace pot is hit during the 14 week, league season, or the ace pot still has cash in it at the beginning of the playoffs there will be a throw-off, only for eligible players who have reached the 10 attendance points, on a pre-determined date, course and hole.
- Finally, I understand that the playoffs will be a single elimination <u>match play</u> on a course, to be determined, for each respective tier.
- Higher seed is on top of the card. Seeding is determined by the overall amount of points accumulated per tier.
- A bracket for Playoffs/Finals will consist of only players that are attending finals.
- Playoff brackets may extend into September 2025 depending on league size.
- I agree to make all my playoff rounds if qualified. I understand if I do not show up to the playoff round my opponent will advance.

Raffle Rules:

- Only members of the Pineland Farms Summer League are eligible to enter or win.
- Players must play on Monday (official league night) to be eligible.
- Each time a player plays their official league round on Monday, they will receive a raffle ticket.
- Players must put their name and phone number on the ticket in legible font to be eligible to win.
- Players will receive 1 ticket each Monday league round they play and must fill out the ticket when they pay their fees for the round. Tickets will not be issued for previous rounds played on Monday nights.
- Three drawings will be held.
 - The first drawing will be after Week 7
 - The Second drawing will be the week of June 23rd (BBQ)
 - o The third drawing will be after Week 14
 - o The number of winners per drawing will depend on the number of total players in the league.
- The drawing held the week of June 23rd will be a special one-day event. Participants must play their league round on Monday, June 23rd to be eligible. Only tickets from that day will be drawn.
- The number of tickets to each players name will reset to zero after each drawing. The maximum number of tickets any one player can have in a drawing is 7.
- Winners will be contacted from the information on their tickets. If a player's contact information cannot be read, they will forfeit their winnings and a new ticket will be drawn.
- Like all other league prizes, raffle winnings must be picked up within 6 months of being selected. League directors will make their best effort to notify winners and provide them with their winnings. Any shipping costs will be at the expense of the winner.
